Game: Mensch Ärgere Dich Nicht! (LUDO)

#### Aims:

- Participants are able to count reliably up to 6 items.
- Read and write numbers up to 40.
- Compare, count and organize own and other pieces (holistic overview).

#### Comments on the Course:

- Lesson has two parts and takes 45 Minutes.
- The game was chosen because of its emotional quality - How to deal with emotions in small groups?
- It encourages logical, mathematical and strategic thinking. In addition you can learn positive discipline!
- Played by 2, 3, 4 or 6 players – one player per board side.
- Age range: 5 Years up, Set up Time: 1 Minute, Playing Time: about 30 Minutes

#### Comments:

- Most popular traditional board game in Germany (invented by J.F. Schmidt 1907/1908 in Munich).
- Today popular in many countries, under different names and in different variants.
- The name of the game derives from the fact that sometimes the play figures are kicked out/ sent back to the waiting field.  
→ irritating for the affected player.
